

Extension of the Deadline for Submissions to the Consultation on Arrangements for Assignment of Additional Spectrum in the 4.9 GHz Band for the Provision of Public Mobile Services and the Related Spectrum Utilisation Fee

The Commerce and Economic Development Bureau and the Office of the Communications Authority (“OFCA”) announced today (13 August 2020) that the deadline for submissions to the consultation paper issued on 22 July 2020 on “Arrangements for Assignment of Additional Spectrum in the 4.9 GHz Band for the Provision of Public Mobile Services and the Related Spectrum Utilisation Fee” has been extended by two weeks to 1 September 2020.

The extension is made in response to requests from the industry, so that interested parties could have more time to submit their written views on the consultation paper. With this extension, the industry and interested parties will have a total of six weeks for submitting their views and comments.

All submissions to the consultation paper should reach OFCA by the extended deadline of 1 September 2020. Submissions made after that date would not be considered.
