We strongly support for the restrictions on sending electronic messages. We welcome very much on the exception of "real-human-call". We hope you can:

1. Increase the penalty from the suggested HK\$100,000 to HK\$500,000 or HK\$1,000,000 to compensate the jobs lost resulted by the electronic machines.
2. Speed up the legislation process as soon as possible with immediate effect rather than waiting till the year of 2006.
