Proposed Updates to Safety Standards for Toys and Children's Products

The Government of the Hong Kong Special Administrative Region (the Government) intends to update Schedules 1 and 2 to the Toys and Children's Products Safety Ordinance (Cap. 424) (the Ordinance) to implement up-to-date safety standards promulgated by the relevant standardisation bodies for toys and children's products listed in Schedule 2 to the Ordinance (Schedule 2 products).

The Ordinance stipulates that a person must not manufacture, import or supply a toy or a Schedule 2 product unless it complies with all the applicable requirements contained in any one of the safety standards (international standards or standards adopted by major economies) specified in Schedule 1 (applicable to toys) or Schedule 2 (applicable to Schedule 2 products) to the Ordinance. The Government keeps in view any updates or amendments to the safety standards so as to apply up-to-date and operative versions of the standards to toys and Schedule 2 products supplied in Hong Kong.

It has come to the Government's attention that, as at the end of May 2025, the following specified safety standards for toys and for four classes of Schedule 2 products have been updated or amended –

- *I.* Toy standards –
- the existing European Standard "BS EN 71-3:2019 + A1:2021" has been updated to "BS EN 71-3:2019 + A2:2024";
- (b) the existing European Standard "BS EN 71-4:2020" has been updated to "BS EN 71-4:2020 + A1:2025"; and
- (c) the existing European Standard "BS EN 71-13:2021 + A1:2022" has been updated to "BS EN 71-13:2021 + A2:2024".
- *II.* Schedule 2 product standards –
- (a) the existing European Standard "BS EN 14988:2017 + A1:2020" for children's high chairs and multi-purpose high chairs for domestic use has been amended to "BS EN 14988:2017 + A2:2024";
- (b) the existing International Standard "ISO 9221-1:2015" for

children's high chairs and multi-purpose high chairs for domestic use has been updated to "ISO 9221:2024";

- (c) the existing International Standard "ISO 9221-2:2015" for children's high chairs and multi-purpose high chairs for domestic use has been updated to "ISO 9221:2024";
- (d) the existing European Standard "BS EN 71-3:2019 + A1:2021" for children's paints has been updated to "BS EN 71-3:2019 + A2:2024";
- (e) the existing ASTM Standard "ASTM F406-22" for playpens for domestic use has been updated to "ASTM F406-24"; and
- (f) the existing Australian Standard "AS 2088:2022" for wheeled child conveyances has been updated to "AS 2088:2022 (incorporating Amendment 1:2024)".
