Existing and planned measures on the promotion of racial equality

Commerce and Economic Development Bureau

The Commerce and Economic Development Bureau (CEDB) formulates and implements various policies on commerce and industry (including external commercial relations and inward investment promotion), support for small and medium enterprises, promotion of Hong Kong's participation in the Belt and Road Initiative, telecommunications, broadcasting, intellectual property protection, consumer protection, competition, film censorship, control of obscene and indecent articles, convention and exhibition, postal services, trade facilitation and wine business, as well as work related to the United Nations Security Council Sanctions. CEDB is assisted by the Trade and Industry Department, overseas Hong Kong Economic and Trade Offices, Invest Hong Kong, Office of the Communications Authority, Radio Television Hong Kong, Intellectual Property Department, Hongkong Post and Customs and Excise Department.

CEDB attaches great importance to ensuring equal access to its services by all members of the public, irrespective of their racial background and, where applicable, will continue to take measures to cater for the service needs of people of diverse race and their other special needs.

Additional Measures Taken/ to be Taken In dealing with information requests and enquiries from people of diverse race, interpretation and translation services in languages other than Chinese or English will be arranged as necessary.

Data on the use of services by service users of diverse race will be collected to facilitate continuous assessment and improvement of service provision.
